



Sergey Vasilievich Ryazantsev, Doctor of Economics, Professor, Corresponding Member of the Russian Academy of Sciences (born April 26, 1973) is a Russian economist, corresponding member of the Russian Academy of Sciences, Doctor of Economics, professor, a leading Russian specialist in demography and population migration. Director of the Institute of Demographic Research of the Federal Research Sociological Center of the Russian Academy of Sciences, Head of the Department of Demographic and Migration Policy of MGIMO of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Russia, Corresponding Member of the Russian Academy of Sciences, Professor, Doctor of Economics. Russian specialist in the field of demography and demographic policy, migration and migration policy of Russia and CIS countries.

In 1995 he graduated from Stavropol State University with a degree in Geography. Subsequently, he graduated from the academic (correspondence) and economic (external) faculties of SSU. He has been a Doctor of Economics since 2002, a professor since 2004. On

December 22, 2011, he was elected a corresponding member of the Russian Academy of Sciences in the Department of Social Sciences (Sociology and Demography).

Since 2002, he headed the Department of Social Demography of the Institute of Socio-Political Studies of the Russian Academy of Sciences, subsequently transformed into the Center for Social Demography and Economic Sociology, then in 2017 he was appointed Director of the Institute of Socio-Political Studies of the Russian Academy of Sciences, in 2020 - Director of the newly created Institute of Demographic Research of the FNSC RAS.

The scientific interests of SV Ryazantsev are related to the study of demographic and migration processes in Russia. The purpose of the research is to establish the dynamics of demographic and migration processes, as well as to develop a theoretical justification and practical recommendations for the formation of demographic and migration policy in the country and individual regions. Author of more than 500 scientific and educational works, including author's and collective monographs ("Migration in Eurasia before and during the Covid-19 pandemic: trends, consequences, migration policy (2021)", "Labor migration in the CIS countries and the Baltics", "Labor migration of women from Russia", "Strategy of the demographic development of Russia", "Demographic and migration portrait of the North Caucasus", "Demographic dictionary", "The impact of migration on the socio-economic development of Europe: current trends", etc. .) The monograph "The Impact of Migration on the Socio-Economic Development of Europe: Modern Trends" was awarded the Prize and Medal of the Russian Academy of Sciences for young scientists in 2002 in the nomination "World Economy". Articles by S. V. Ryazantsev have been published in leading Russian scientific journals, including International Processes, Economic Issues, Population, Sociological Research, Social Sciences and Modernity, Migration, Nature, Man and labor", "World economy and international relations". Individual works have been published abroad in the USA, France and Switzerland, including in the journal Sociological Research, he regularly publishes articles in the journals Scopus and WoS.

Member of the editorial boards of scientific journals Sociological research, Demographic research, International processes, Population, Bulletin of St. Petersburg University. Economics, Scientific review. Series 1. Economics and Law (Chairman, Editor-in-Chief), Scientific Review. Series 2. Humanities (Chairman, Editor-in-Chief).

Member of scientific associations: International Sociological Association (ISA); European Sociological Association (ESA); International Union for the Scientific Study of Population (IUSSP); European Association of Population Studies (EAPS).

In 2002, as an expert, he prepared the report "External labor migration in Russia" for the international migration department of the International Labor Organization (ILO) in Geneva (Switzerland), which was highly appreciated by foreign researchers. In total, S. V. Ryazantsev underwent scientific internships several times, took part in international research projects from the Russian side, carried out within the framework of the department in the International Migration Department of the ILO and the International Organization for Migration in 2000, 2002, 2003, 2005, 2006 and 2007. Participated as an invited expert in the Migration and Economic Development panel at the United Nations Population Division in New York in July 2005.

The research results have found application in the practice of managing demographic and migration processes in Russia. Participated as a member of working groups in the development of the Concept of the Demographic Policy of the Russian Federation for the period up to 2025 (Approved by Decree of the President of the Russian Federation of October 9, 2007 No. 1351); State program to assist voluntary resettlement to the Russian Federation of compatriots living abroad (Approved by Decree of the President of the Russian Federation dated June 22, 2006 No. 637). He is a member of the Expert Advisory Council on Migration Issues under the Main Directorate for Migration Issues of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Russia. Has gratitude and a medal from the Federal Migration Service of Russia. Chairman of the Scientific Council "Demographic and Migration Problems of Russia" at the Department of Social Sciences of the Russian Academy of Sciences. Chairman of the Dissertation Council D 002.011.04 at the Federal Scientific Research Center of the Russian Academy of Sciences on economic sciences (population economics and demography, labor economics). Organizer and chairman of the organizing committees of the largest international scientific forums "Migration Bridges in Eurasia" (2009-2021) and "All-Russian Demographic Forum" (2019-2021).

Head of research projects supported by the Russian Science Foundation, the Russian Foundation for Basic Research, the Russian Humanitarian Science Foundation. Founder and head of the leading scientific school on migration and migration policy at the Department of Demographic and Migration Policy of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the MGIMO of Russia, supported twice by grants from the Grants Council under the President of the Russian Federation. Advised international UN agencies on migration issues, including UNFPA, IOM, ILO, UNDP, ESCAP.

S. V. Ryazantsev successfully combines scientific work with scientific and pedagogical activities, he was awarded the badge "Excellent worker of public education." He is the head of the Department of Demographic and Migration Policy at the Moscow State Institute of International Relations of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Russia, a professor at the Peoples' Friendship University of Russia (PFUR), where he lectures on migration and migration policy. He developed and published an educational and methodological complex for the course "International labor market and migration", which includes a textbook, teaching aid, program, dictionary. He has worked as a visiting professor at leading Russian and foreign universities, including Tomsk State University, North Caucasian Federal University, Belgorod State National Research University, Kazan (Volga Region) Federal University, Hitotsubashi University (Japan), Rio State University de Janeiro (Brazil), University of Sydney (Australia), Corvinus University (Hungary), University of Hokkaido (Japan), University of Bucharest (Romania), European University Institute (Italy), Charles University (Czech Republic), University of California Davis (USA). Honorary Professor of the Tajik State University of Law, Business and Politics.

Under the leadership of Ryazantsev S.V. 6 doctors and 47 candidates of sciences defended their dissertations on demography and migration from Russia, Tajikistan, Iran, Syria, China.
